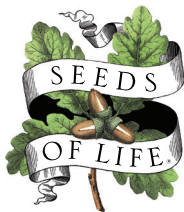

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Congratulations on the receipt of your Olive tree. By following the growing and care information listed below you can grow a tree that will add beauty and interest to any living space.

PLANTING & GROWING DIRECTIONS

1. Carefully unpack your Olive tree upon arrival. Remove burlap and plastic bag covering the container.
2. Find a sunny location where it can receive as much natural light as possible (up to full sun). It is important to keep your tree moist but not excessively wet at all times. Water your tree twice a week until run off is sufficient. You can grow your Olive tree for a number of years as a patio plant by just transplanting it into a large container with potting soil.



CONTAINER PLANTING: If you live in a northern environment where you experience severe freezing temperatures (colder than 15 degrees F), it would be good to plant your Olive tree in a container which can be brought indoors during the cold winter months. Once the danger of frost has passed, bring your Olive tree outdoors into the full sun again for another growing season. Always check your container to see that the roots have ample enough room to grow. Pick a container that is 3 to 4 inches wider in diameter than the current pot.

LANDSCAPE PLANTING: A lot of care has been taken in growing your Olive tree. Your tree will become a specimen in your landscape. Make sure your winter lows do not dip below 18 degrees F. Pick a spot in the full sun or a minimum of five hours of direct sunlight. Follow in-ground planting instructions on attached planting card.
